Qualification 1 x 6 Games (cross lane / lane change after 2 games)

Sunday 6.1.2019 – 10:00 (max. 25 participants)
Sunday 6.1.2019 – 13:00 (max. 25 participants)

Please arrive at the bowling center around 30 minutes before scheduled starting time.

Finale will take place after the last preliminary round

Sun., ca. 16:00 Final Step 1: 9-24 seeded after qualification
(3 Games – lane change after each game)

Sun., ca. 17:15 Final Step 2: Top 8 from Step 1 + Top 8 from qualification
(3 Games – lane change after each game)

Steppladder Final: Top 5 from Final Step 2 (1 game)

Lane Conditioning

Lane will be conditioned before each qualification round and before final step 1.

Handicap / Winners Determination

Each player will receive the following bonus for the proof of her/his average:

Each player uses a minimum of 18 games in each association as a basis. In case of multiple affiliation, the report with the highest average is scored.

Participants (m / f / d) without average proof or with less than 18 games will receive the Hdc. after the respective qualification series.



If there is a tie incl. bonus in the preliminary round, decides on the placement of the result without Hdc. If this is the same, the higher 6th net game decides.

From final step 1, a one-ball roll-off (net) will always be played on the cut and prize pools (When there is a tie including the Hdc).

The results of the preliminary round will not be taken to next round. Each final round starts at zero pins. The maximum pin number per game incl. Hdc. is 300.

Fees and Prizopot

The entry fee is € 30 per participant. This includes the game prize and a drink of your choice. Youth players (≤18) pay € 20 entry fee for ½ prize.

There are no additional costs for the final. Payment is in cash.

Re-entry is possible upon availability. First starts have priority over re-entries until 1.1.2019. Everyone can only qualify once for the final.
